### Expert Tine Klint has been voted onto the board of the European Film Academy

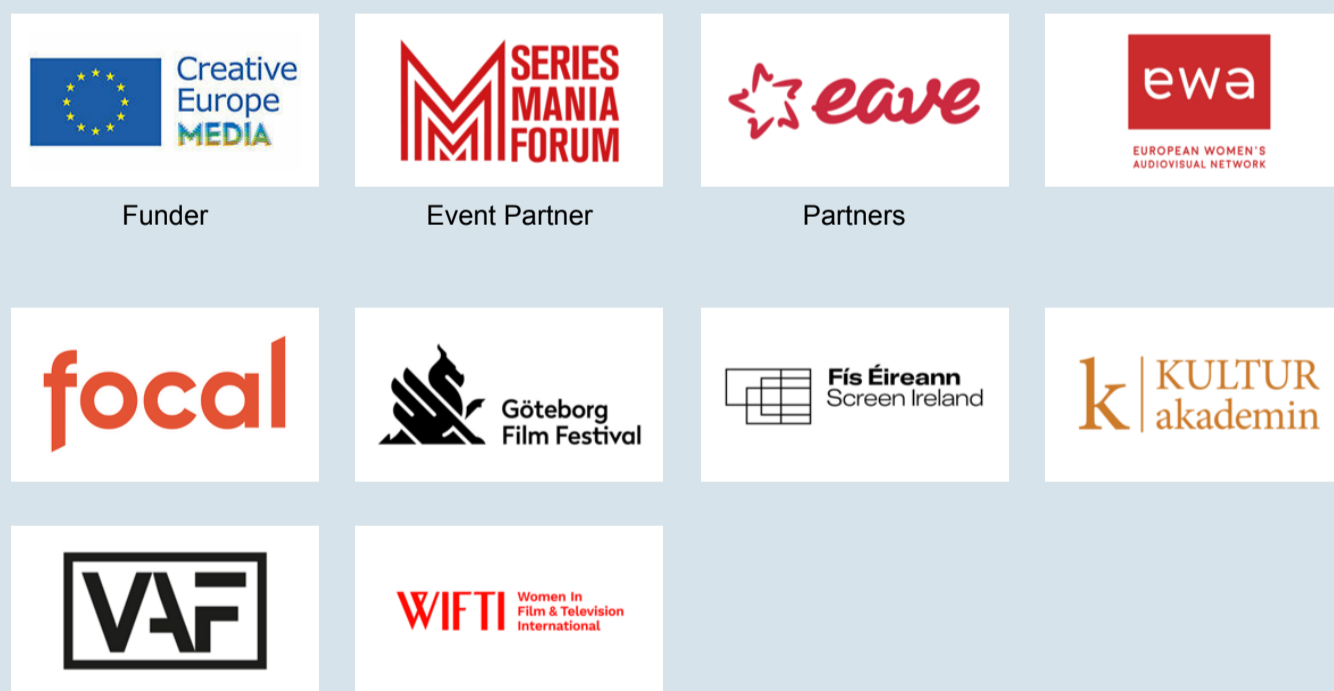

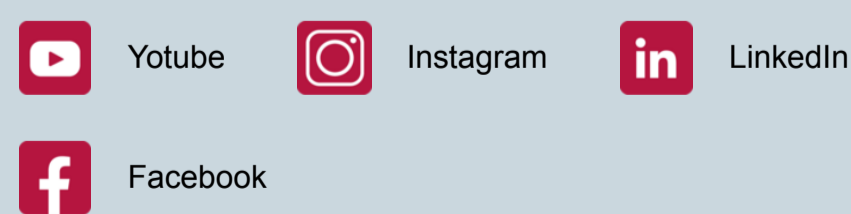
